Supported by Macclesfield Town Council who organised the inaugural event, Cycle Saturday has now been handed over to the community; with Darren Allgood from Allgood Cycling picking up the reins. Darren is also a member of local cycling group Macclesfield Wheelers who are involved with the day.

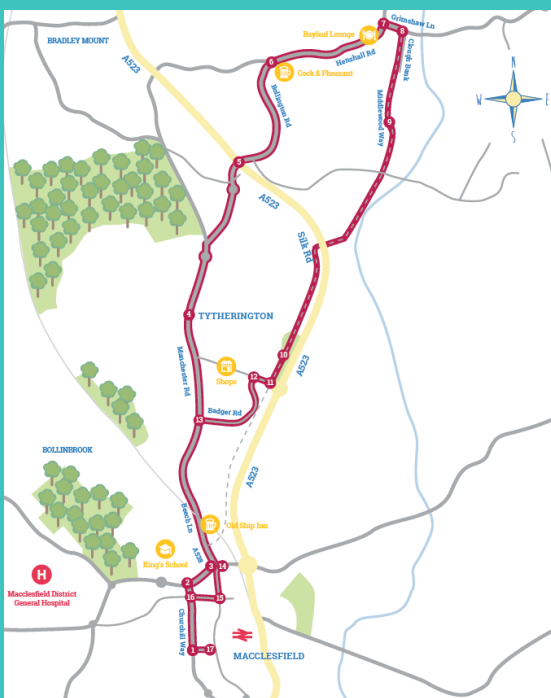

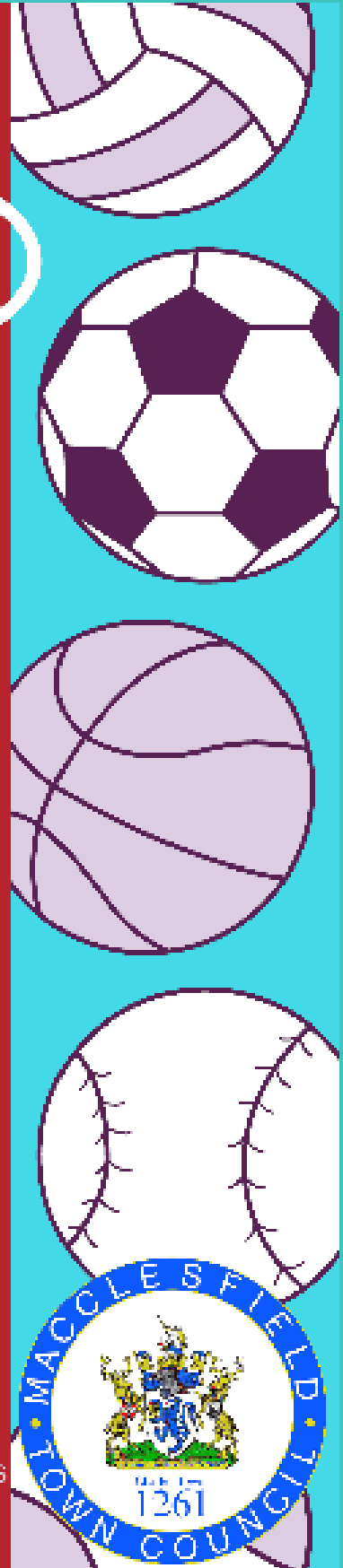

# Applications Open for Community Grants

Since its inception in 2015, Macclesfield Town Council has provided a Community Grant Scheme to support projects, events and activities in Macclesfield that demonstrate a benefit to residents and communities in the town.



Macclesfield Council has, to date, granted around £70,000 through its Community Grant Scheme to activities as diverse as the Potato Riot to the provision of community training.
