Recently the Communications sub group has evolved into MTC facilitating a meeting with all those involved in comms in Macclesfield to come together and share information and communication channels. This is led by Cllr Jackson and the Communications Officer.

The Outdoor Hospitality sub group is chaired by Cllr Fiona Wilson, and recent actions are:

- Disseminating information and advertising how to get pavement licenses to local businesses
- Supporting the Say Hi to the Hight Street campaign.
- Reviewing events in the town centre and footfall data
- Supporting trials of outdoor hospitality
- Exploring how the town centre can be hold more events including MTC checking on the electrics at the Town Hall for outdoor events
- Exploring opportunities for the Town Hall, markets and Park Green.

The Environmental sub group is lead by Matt Todd of Scoop and Scales who will be supported by Aoife Middlemass of CVS.

The Art and Culture forum is attended by several members of the TCRWG, and Emma Anderson, of Macclesfield Museums feeds into the group from this forum.

The group is diverse, sharing information and opportunities for Macclesfield, including:

- CEC Town Hall Feasibility Study
- CEC Macclesfield Markets Consultations
- Peaks and Plains developments including The Crossings
- The Welcome Back Fund – the Town Council have benefited from Gazeboes, deckchairs, planters and tables and chairs which the community can use. The Art and Culture forum are discussing the procurement of light boxes.
- The Town Councils Britain in Bloom Campaign
