These 10 young people support hundreds of others in this district to be involved with positive learning activities. Engaging young people in these sorts of positive programmes has considerable benefits for the local communities in which they live. The ability to attend the Jamboree is the pinnacle for a scout. By attending next year's Jamboree the 10 young people will help motivate others by seeing that they too can achieve this experience. They have already started on this process by delivering presentations to their local groups and taking part in the district camp. We are planning that some of the fundraising events will have a direct impact on opportunities for local young people to be involved, for example with our district abseil challenge.
