<p>Short project description:</p>	<p>CFRS will deliver a free 12 week Prince's Trust personal development programme for young people aged 16-25 who are usually not in education, employment or training. The Programme is accredited though non-statutory, and we usually deliver 3 programmes per year in Macclesfield. The Programme will support up to 14 young people from various backgrounds who all face different personal challenges (eg. anxiety, depression, low self esteem, limiting beliefs, no ambition, domestic abuse, self harm, bullied at school, anger issues, ADHD, sofa surfing, disability, debt, single parenthood, alcohol and/or drugs misuse) preventing them from fulfilling their potential, enjoying life and living up to expectations of 'normal' young people.</p> <p>Each Programme begins with team building activities, including a week at a residential activity centre. It continues with a community project and team challenge followed by individual work placements to gain practical experience. The programme culminates in a Team graduation.</p> <p>A grant from Macclesfield Town Council will be used to pay for materials and equipment required to deliver the community project element of the Programme (eg. repainting a youth club, develop a community garden at an older people's home). As the actual project is decided by the Team, it is not possible to say with certainty today what the exact project will be. The Team will endeavour to raise some funds themselves.</p>
<p>If you receive a grant, briefly tell us what difference it will make to your organisation/area:</p>	<p>Difference to the young people: The Programme inspires and develops socially disadvantaged young people to move forward in fulfilling their potential to secure work placements, apprenticeships, training and/or volunteering opportunities. Personal outcomes will include uncovering hidden talents, assuming responsibility for tasks, developing teamworking and communication skills, gaining awareness of their local community and how they can contribute to it, plus gaining nationally recognised qualifications (eg. in food hygiene, health and safety). Young people will be given confidence and lifeskills to help them move towards greater independence.</p> <p>Difference to the local community: The type of community project outlined above will improve a facility, whether that be a youth club, older people's home, community garden or community centre, for example. In our previous experience, Prince's Trust community projects help to improve the physical and emotional wellbeing of people of all ages and backgrounds who use the facilities.</p>
