To update members on leisure and outdoor activity projects

7.1 Parks and Play Areas

Banbury Park:

Cllr Bennet Wake has fed back that the new plants in the park are a great addition, and that the drainage issues seem to be easing. With the remainder of the funding the Town Council will work with Ansa on a gravel/stone path from bridge 34 to the hardcore, where the old garages used to be at the back of Delamere Drive as the grass gets very muddy and difficult for those with mobility issues to access the bridge to the tow path or sit on the park bench. This ties in with the Town Council active travel ambitions.

Windmill Park:

The Town Council has committed £26,500 to the skate park. Ansa are working on a plan for this amount approx.

Weston:

The equipment was installed in June 2022. The artwork brief is awaiting confirmation of which part of the park will be painted which is likely to be the sides of the skate ramps.

South Park Masterplan

Ansa are currently running a consultation with the public on the South Park Masterplan, this also includes the opportunity to give views on the South Park Pavilion.

7.2 South Park Pavilion

Bower Matin are now in place as the architects to design the pavilion. The working party met on June 13th to discuss the design and Bower Matin will then produce 2 designs. These will go out to the public in various forms to garner views including at a Civic event being held in the park on August 13th to celebrate the centenary of the park.

7.3 Playing Out

This project is now moving into pilot phase. Two sessions will be held in partnership with Cre8. If these go well, we will look to holding them on a more long-term basis from Spring 2023.

Cllr Fiona Wilson and Cheshire East Councillor Brian Puddicombe have kindly agreed to support the road closures for these sessions utilising their Traffic Management qualifications.

The sessions will be held on 28th July and 9th August in South ward.

7.4 Allotments

Knowsley Road:

We recently carried out a site inspection. It was great to meet a number of plot holders on the day. Several allotments were identified as not being under cultivation. Non cultivation letters have been sent and a follow up site visit will take place.

Springfield Road:

A site inspection has been carried out in June. One plot was identified as not being cultivated. The process is being followed to address this.

Park Grove:

We will be carrying out a site inspection in July.

Invoices were sent out for all plots on 1st April. Those who haven't yet paid have received a reminder.

7.5 Street sports

Street sports is well attended and below are the attendance figures from recent sessions.

Sessions are going well with the same regular participants on a weekly basis.

Cllr Ruth Thompson identified that the sessions held at Jasmine Park do not have consistent attendance and suggested a return to Becks Lane playing fields. Having spoken to Peak Active sports, they agreed with the proposed change and we are now seeking permission to move from Cheshire East Council.
