Background

Community consultation - the 100+ community and school responses and responses have been collated anonymously and shared with the planning consultant.

Internal review of draft Character Assessment – comments on the draft consultation were sought from MTC Councillors by 14/01/22.

Internal review comments have been passed to the planning consultant.
