Further to last services and finance committee where Councillors approved the budget of £20k to spend on signage around the town, the Town Centre Manager has been looking into guideline prices which would give a clearer indication of what can be achieved for the money prior to seeking 3 competitive quotes and gaining planning permission.

A local provider has given some approximate costings based on the following;

- Castle Quarter – 3 x hanging signs, made from powder coated aluminum, mounted with a wrought iron style bracket
- Archway for Back Wallgate – Wrought metal archway fabricated in Bollington
- Directory sign for indoor market – A0 size sign, showing a full directory of traders within the Indoor Market
- Banners – 2 x PVC banners advertising the Indoor Market to go on the back of the building, along Churchill way
- Lampost Signs – 5 x lamppost signs which can direct from train station to town centre/shopping area, advertise the indoor market
- Maps – 3 x monolith maps, full colour and fabricated from steel and aluminium, with an anti graffiti finish (non illuminated) to be placed at train station, Park Green and Town Centre.

Approx. £17k

This is very encouraging, and means we can now refine the specifications for the items, confirm sizes, locations etc, and then start the process of getting quotes and applying for the relevant planning permission.
