It was noted that the group was formed following mutual growth of interest in the recognition of international cultural ties, the town's historic silk trading importance and the multi-faceted value of closer relationships with other towns, cities and countries.

As the historic and identified western end of the Silk Road, it was considered apt to communicate with the identified eastern end of the road. This is identified as Xi'an in China.

Consideration of locally held artefacts relating to China was mentioned and the Silk Heritage Museums would be contacted to see if a display of suitable items might be possible.

It was agreed that schools would be asked to provide information on work their pupils are undertaking
