3.1 Mr G Barrow

Following the programme, Graham was contacted by Mr Gongzheng Ren, the General Manager of the Shaanxi Tourism Group Co Ltd, with a view to exploring if links between Macclesfield and Xi'an/Shaanxi could be developed.

Mr Ren is hoping to facilitate a visit Macclesfield in spring 2018 and is seeking an invitation from Macclesfield Town Council.
