

**NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
CHESHIRE EAST BOROUGH COUNCIL
(BUXTON ROAD AND MONSALL DRIVE, MACCLESFIELD)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING)
ORDER 2022**

Notice is hereby given that the Cheshire East Borough Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4, and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the 1984 Act") and all other enabling powers and in accordance with its duty under Section 122 of the 1984 Act.

1. The effect of the proposed Order will be to introduce a prohibition of waiting by vehicles at all times on all days on the following lengths and sides of road;

Buxton Road (south west side) – from a point in line with the common boundary of property Nos. 392 and 394 Buxton Road in a south easterly direction to a point in line with the common boundary of property Nos. 396 and 398 Buxton Road.

Monsall Drive (both sides) – from its junction with Buxton Road for a distance of 12.5 metres in a south westerly direction.

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STATEMENT OF REASONS

Effect

The effect of the proposed Order will be to introduce a prohibition of waiting by vehicles at all times on all days on the following lengths and sides of road;

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Monsall Drive (both sides) – from its junction with Buxton Road for a distance of 12.5 metres in a south westerly direction.

Reasons

Monsall Drive is a residential road accessed via Buxton Road, Macclesfield. Although some of the properties close to this junction have off street parking facilities there is still a demand for on street parking for residents and their visitors.

Complaints have been received with regard to vehicles parked on both sides of Monsall Drive, close to its junction with Buxton Road, reducing visibility and causing problems for access, in particular for larger vehicles such as delivery vans and refuse wagons.

In response to the complaints received, site visits have been undertaken which witnessed some of these problems and as such it is considered necessary to propose the introduction of no waiting at any time restrictions at this junction to improve both visibility and access to Monsall Drive.

Due to the impact that any restrictions could have on local residents and giving consideration to the affect that displaced vehicles could have on nearby areas, the extents of the proposed restrictions have been kept to a minimum.

The proposed waiting restrictions will prevent parking from close to this junction, which will improve access, visibility, and the free movement of traffic.

The Ward Member, Parking Services and Police support this proposal.

In respect of section 122 of the 1984 Act the Authority is seeking to secure the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic through the provision of waiting provisions whilst also keeping the restrictions to a minimum to take into account its duty to provide suitable and adequate parking on street.
