#### **10.4 Community Enforcement**

Our partnership with Community Enforcement began in January and we now have set procedures for dealing with isolated and ongoing issues.

Issues that can be dealt with are:

- Abandoned vehicles (more than 4 weeks unless they are in a state of disrepair)
- Dog fouling
- Fly tipping
- Business Waste
- Litter

Since 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2023 (the last report), the Community Enforcement Officer has dealt with the below number of incidents up until 15<sup>th</sup> June 2023:

Abandoned vehicles: 36

Fly tipping: 15

Dog fouling: 13

Dog fouling sign request: 1

Littering: 1

Patrol plans are in force for Christchurch, Heatheridge Close, High Street area and Windmill Park. These areas receive patrols at least weekly. One warning has been issued to a suspected dog fouling in the High Street area.

There has been positive feedback reported in Tytherington that the patrol plan has been effective and reduced the number of dog fouling incidents significantly.

The Assistant Town Clerk is trying to connect CCTV with the Community Enforcement Officer to arrange a meeting. A meeting is also being arranged with the CEO and the town centre PCSO.
