Match Funding

£1629 represents the estimated value of parcels already distributed since April 2022 which has been supported by the general public making donations to the Silklife Church Baby-bank. The Silklife Church has

	further promised a cash injection of £500 to complete the required match funding for this 2k grant if successful. Through further appeals to the general public the Silklife Church will guarantee that the number of parcels and kits explained above will be match funded which means a total of 40 kits, 40 reusable nappy parcels and 28 families per month supported moving forward for the next 12 months.
