- Church Hire
- Staging Hire from King Edward Music Society
- Contribution toward marketing costs in Macclesfield

The first two items totalled £1054.80 paid to Macclesfield-based organisations.

How many people benefited from your project/activity or attended if it was an event?

Audiences - 458

Volunteers - 8

Professional Musicians and staff - 33

What was the outcome of your grant?

Two musically extremely successful concerts. This was the first time that we have performed in St Michael's Church, the Heritage Centre having ended our 30 year association in 2021/22. As we feared, the reduced capacity and poorer sightlines appear to have slightly

negatively affected audience numbers on previous years. However, those who did attend commented very positively on the sound and atmosphere of professional music in the Church and we did see a slight increase in numbers for the second. As reduced audience figures results in smaller box-office income, we are extremely grateful to Macclesfield Town Council for providing the additional support to smooth this transition year.

What have you learned from this project?

That there is definitely an audience for more intimate concerts in St Michaels. To project for smaller audience figures at St Michael's concerts. As a consequence, we are likely to programme works requiring smaller numbers of musicians, reducing costs. This will ensure future viability of these concerts.


