The ranger team have been busy carrying out winter work.

Alongside the day-to-day work of litter picking, strimming, weeding, road sign painting, at this time of year, there is a lot of leaf blowing and clearing to be done.

They have also carried out a lot of work on the Knowsley Road allotment site to improve the fencing, pathways and car park area. This has proven invaluable in the recent wet weather.

The rangers have completed a lot of work on renovating street signs which has made a real difference across the town.

The team have been supporting events by moving equipment and road closure signage both before and after the events.

The Jasmine Park Christmas tree was put into place and secured by the ranger team.

The Britain in Bloom committee have been meeting regularly and the rangers have been assessing the proposed wildflower locations for suitability. A walk round of the sites with Highways is due to take place at the end of February.

The rangers have also been involved with trying to resolve the water drainage issue at the Laburnum Road allotment site.

Ongoing work includes replenishment of the dog fouling bags and litter picking across the town.
