9.1 Footfall Data

The Town Council now receives copies of the Cheshire East footfall figures; a monthly report which is based on phone usage, and also a weekly report which comes from the physical counter in the town centre.

It is worth remembering that the phone usage data counts people as they enter the town centre 'zone' and they are only counted once.

The weekly data is counting people every time they pass the counter, which could be multiple times in one day.

What the data is evidencing.

Events that are held in the Town Centre are drawing more people into town and we can see this with the following footfall figures.

Treacle continues to be a big draw for the town, with approx. 10k more counts than a normal Sunday.

The Do Something Summer programme does show increase in footfall, as Street Photography, Kite Making and Circus Skills. Activities such as Chalk Art were on very rainy days and as such as would not expect to see that much of an increase.

Heritage Open Day saw an increase of nearly 10% more counts than a normal Saturday.

Monthly report for August 2023 (not yet received September 2023 figures at time of writing 13/9/23)

Key Points are:

- The total number of visitors for the year to date is 1,718,470 which is 3.5% down on the previous year.
- The total number of visitors to Macclesfield in August was 204,275.
- The busiest day was Sunday 27 August (Treacle Market) with 13,894 visitors.
