#### What was the outcome of your grant?





The Macclesfield Civic Society is now in its 62<sup>nd</sup> year with the motto Making the Town a Better Place to Live.

A key part of their activity is the Annual Awards event, which aims to recognise developments and community-based activities that do as the motto says, make the town a better place to live. You can email us (address below) for a programme of our activities for the current year.

Last year an award went to Peaks and Plains for their Crossings Development on Park Green which has replaced the fire damaged mill. But it's not only large schemes which are recognised in this way. At the other end of the scale The Flower House and café in the former Barclays Bank building, also on Park Green, has brought life to another important but disused building.

The Society also recognises achievements of clubs and societies such as the organisers of the Barnaby Festival, and the Town Council for their flower planters which brighten the town during summer.

If there is any new development, or upgraded building such as a new shopfront, or any event or activity that you think has improved the Town in the past year then the Civic Society would like to hear from you. The only requirement for your nomination is that the project must have been completed in the year to 31st December 2023.
