The Project

The project will bring large-scale installations to the town centre over a 7–8 week period, starting in November 2025 and running through to January 2026.

A dedicated social media campaign will run alongside the project, reaching beyond Macclesfield to other nearby areas accessible by train. The campaign will align with the town's already busy Christmas programme.
