## **Background**

In 2021, following Cheshire East Council's (CEC) review and update of its gritting policies and the criteria used to determine which roads are gritted, Macclesfield Town Council (MTC) agreed to fund the gritting of several additional roads. These roads continue to be gritted at the Town Council's expense and the cost this year will be £3,800.01 for 65 treatments. There is £3000 in the budget for this already.

CEC has since completed a further review of its grit box provision. MTC Councillors have assessed the grit box provision within their respective wards and have submitted requests to Cheshire East Highways for additional grit boxes and refills. These additional boxes and refills will be funded by the individual Councillors' ward budgets for the current financial year.
