Please describe how your grant was used:

The grant was used to help support the fundraising efforts of 31 Scouts and Explorers who attended an International Scout Camp in Kandersteg, Switzerland in August 2025.

How many people benefited from your project/activity or attended if it was an event?

In total there are 31 young people (11yrs to 17 yrs) from 3<sup>rd</sup> Macclesfield Scout Group and Maasai Explorers attended the International Scout Camp in Kandersteg, supported by 7 adult leaders.

What was the outcome of your grant?

31 young people, aged between 11 and 17, had the opportunity to travel to the Kandersteg International Scout Centre in Switzerland and take part in an international camp with approximately 1000 other young people from around the world.

During their time at the camp our young people had the opportunity to take part in a range of cultural activities where new friendships around the world were forged, they took part in various adventurous activities including swimming in Alpine lakes, hiking to over 2000m (650m higher than Ben Nevis!) to stay in an Alpine hut overnight, zip lining and much more.

The young people also got involved in multiple eco activities, leant about the history of the Kandersteg and World Scouting and topped off the week by attending the final campfire of the Kandersteg summer calendar along with over 600 Scouts and Explorers from across the world.

It was an amazing week where leaders got the opportunity to see our youngest Scouts growing in confidence and taking on challenges they will remember for a lifetime and some of our older Explorer grow into promising leaders of the future.


What have you learned from this project?

Given the right opportunities, young people can do amazing things!


