Please describe how your grant was used:

We used the grant to buy a selection of sporting goods and outdoor games for the brownies to use. These where a range of physical games like bean bag toss, tennis, pickleball and badminton. To agility games forming miniature assault courses in teams using hurdles, cones and nets. And finally mental games like connect four to channel them in all aspect, not just physically.

The other part of the grant was used to buy gardening supplies for the area at the back of st Barnabas church where we have been given a raised bed to look after.

How many people benefited from your project/activity or attended if it was an event?

The 9 brownies and 3 leaders directly benefit from theses materials. The church also has a gardening group that will have access to the gardening tools during set times and stored safely when not in use.

What was the outcome of your grant?

The outcome is we have been able to do more activities with the brownies and allowed them to have hands on experience. For the brownies that don't have gardens at home they have been able to attend each week and directly see the progress of there efforts while learn about the foods. Not only how to grow it but also ways to prepare and cook it.

What have you learned from this project?

This has opened a lot of the brownies eyes to food production and the food waste system. We hope to grow more and more each year and getting more of the community involved with it.
