






Police 100 Council/Other 3 Insurance/3rd Party 5



Missing Persons

During Q1 the team were tasked with assisting Police with finding a several vulnerable missing persons. Of the jobs tasked to CCTV across Macclesfield, CCTV located 100u% of them and guided Police to their current location allowing them to be stopped and taken to a place of safety.

Drugs

CCTV operator spotted two persons acting in a suspicious way in a local park. Whilst monitoring, a known person attends and deals them drugs. CCTV contact Police who arrive and arrest the dealer for possession with intent

Drugs

CCTV monitor suspicious activity on Gas Road. This seems to be drug related so Police informed. Plain clothed officers make their way as suspect leaves in taxi. Suspect later returns to the scene in another car where Police stop the individual. Person was arrested with a lot of cash and drugs, the car is seized as uninsured and used in crime.

Wanted person

Police inform CCTV of a wanted person believed to be in the Macclesfield area. Within minutes of being informed, CCTV spot the person on the outskirts of town, contact Police and said person is arrested.

Assaul

Group spotted on Mill Street who look to be having a heated argument. CCTV request Police make their way and fly the flag when one person assaults another and makes off. CCTV track offender and victim in seperate directions guiding Police to both. Suspect soon arrested and help called to treat the victim

Projects and News

Radio Link

Radio Link has been reviewed in full and made digital. This is now being rolled out in two towns in the borough to test before being rolled out in other towns. Radio Link will depend on the input of the local Town Council along with businesses as the new digital plan is to run both a digital radio link to the CCTV Control Room along with an online (app and PC) portal for reporting incidents, for getting access to Police images of offenders, for asking other members to help identifying any persons they have images of who have committed crime and private messaging members along with the Control Room team. More information will be made available soon.

Continued Review

The service continue to review its operation and have identified areas within Macclesfield where we may be able to move cameras to keep up with changing crime trends and types. This work will begin once other major projects have been completed but some will require the assistance and backing of the Town Council. We are also undergoing further service change at the moment to drive faster communication, tasking, reporting, scheduling and audit across the service. This is being tested at management level currently with a go live date in August all being well. More information will be available once live.
