What have you learned from this project?

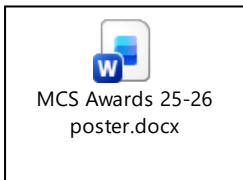
Our experience this year is that developers and builders, particularly those local to Macclesfield, appreciate just as much as ever the recognition of their efforts in improving the fabric of the Town.
