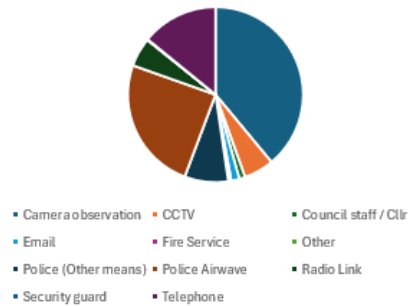

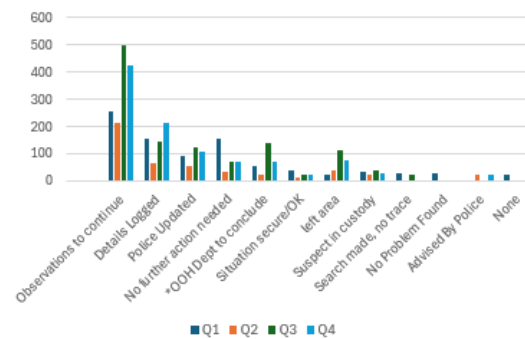

Fight Churchyard Side

CCTV informed of a fight on Churchyard side. CCTV on in the area and locate the incident. CCTV radio Police who are soon on scene and arrests made. .

Burglary

CCTV receive reports of a shop burglary that has occurred over night in an area off camera. Operators start a full review of footage just in case they spot anything suspicious as nothing to go on at premises bar a lot of stock taken. CCTV locate persons in town much earlier and have great images of them. We then notice as we investigate further, the same group coming from the direction of the store at the time of the burglary. CCTV produce all evidence for Police.

Drugs

CCTV observe person snorting drugs in the town. CCTV radio Police as this often leads to violent crimes. Police guided in and soon get hold of person who is arrested.

Safety of Women At Night

We are currently working on a project in the south on this very subject as the government have started to quite rightly press councils to ensure they have provision for it. As such, we are rolling out Help Points which people can press if they ever feel concerned. Their call comes straight through to the Control Room where operators can see and speak to them plus then use a local town centre camera to view the concern. This is a trial and one of a few things we are looking at now that we have created mesh safety networks across our towns including Knutsford that we can make use of for more than just the CCTV (a full range of safety measures). I will keep all updated on this. Knutsford is a key place for the night time economy and an area that was once not a nice area to be in. We have such a handle on things now that its a perfect night out so ensuring women are and feel safe to enjoy the delights of Knutsford is key for my service. Knutsford is a place i am really proud of our work on.

Expansion

We are currently working on expanding our coverage by taking on CCTV Cameras at Jordangate Car Park and the Bus Station in Macclesfield which will give us additional ability to track offenders even on escape routes. These are projects due to take off in May of this year.

Residents

I spoke to a handful of residents over the last week as i went out doing an audit of kit in Macclesfield and normally i don't include these as i speak to people often but the feedback i had from people was just out of this world! The support, how it makes people feel safe, how its great that we are "catching the bad guys" and the rest. Its really great to see the impact of CCTV direct from those who matter the most, the people it is there to protect. I wanted to include that because A) CCTV is often a marmite subject but it seems in Cheshire East, has incredible support and B) Its thanks to you as a Town Council supporting us that allows us to produce the excellent results be continue to achieve
